More than 10 million people watched iconic news journalist Brian Ross interview Scott, as the whistleblower in the federal grant making scandal at the U.S. Department of Justice. Mr. Peterson took a stand against the federal government and exposed the cronyism, public deception, fraud, and abuse taking place at the U.S. Department of Justice's Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention by high ranking Presidential appointees who were misappropriating tens of millions of tax payer dollars intended for fair competition to benefit our most vulnerable children and youth. The mission of Global Youth Justice is to promote the global expansion of quality juvenile justice/youth justice programs often referred to as youth court, teen court, peer court, student court, youth peer jury, and youth peer panel. These rapidly expanding local juvenile justice/youth justice programs harness positive peer pressure and utilize it in a peer judgment setting to adjust the anti-social, delinquent, and/or criminal behavior of other youth. The peer judgment and positive peer pressure aspects of these juvenile justice/youth justice programs are the two primary programmatic elements which separate these diversion programs from all the others.
