The Global Youth Justice Monthly e-News passes 10,400 Adult and Youth subscribers from around the Globe.

The Global Youth Justice Monthly e-News passed 10,400 subscribers by the end of 2010. More than 1,500 more adults and youth subscribed to the Global Youth Justice Monthly e-News from March 1, 2010 to December 31, 2010. Global Youth Justice's Scott Peterson has maintained the largest database of local Youth Justice programs since 1993, when Scott Peterson started his first Youth Court in New York. This continued from 1997 to 2008, while Scott worked at OJJDP/U.S. Department of Justice and now continues at his Global Youth Justice. Interest is stronger

#4 Global Youth Justice and our (2) Partners Win a \$1 Million Grant from the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention in 2010. Woo Hoo!!!

On September 15, 2010, the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention, United States Department of Justice announced Global Youth Justice and it's two (2) Partners Won a \$1 Million Dollar Federal Grant. This Grant will fund research on Mentoring and Juvenile Justice Settings to Include Teen Court/Youth Court, Juvenile Probation, Juvenile Court and several other settings. This was our first win for Global Youth Justice on a competitive federal grant. This grant will go through September 30, 2012. Scott Peterson also wrote a \$10 Million Dollar Winning Grant for his good buddies at Big Brothers Big Sisters of America in 2010. Thank you OJJDP - 2010 was a great year for us!

#3 Canada, Japan, Australia, Europe, and Guam make Youth Justice Progress and Start Planning in 2010.

Global Youth Justice is now helping more than a dozen Counties and Territories with a wide range of Youth Justice Implementation and Enhancement efforts. Global Youth Justice will head to Canada in March/2011; Japan in August/2011; Europe in October and other global efforts are being scheduled for 2011 and 2012. Global Youth Justice Trainings will welcome even more international participants at our upcoming International Trainings scheduled to take place in 2011.
